

Weddings at Tualatin Presbyterian Church

Tualatin Presbyterian Church, nestled next to a wooded park, provides a lovely setting for a wedding; the sanctuary windows look out on greenery.

The Rev. Ken Evers-Hood can lead the service, if available, or you may have another pastor lead the service. For this, TPC session approval is required.

The church sanctuary can seat a maximum of 300 guests. Chairs can be rearranged or removed to accommodate a smaller group.

The sanctuary has a grand piano. One of our pianists can play at your wedding, if available. You may provide your own musician of choice, or use music on CD's. Use of the piano in the sanctuary requires the approval of our music director.

To reserve a wedding date on the church calendar, availability of the church, the pastor and the support personnel must be confirmed and a \$100 deposit paid.

Fees associated with a wedding include:

- Building Use and Custodial Fee

- Sound System Operator

- Wedding Hostess

- Pianist – If Pastor Ken leads the service, music is required.

- Honorarium to Pastor

Note: Fees for non-members are higher than for members.

The policy of the Presbyterian Church (USA), states that at least one member of the couple must affirm the Christian faith.

The use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs on the church property is prohibited. Smoking is not allowed. The throwing of rice, confetti, or birdseed is also not permitted. Candles must be ivory or white, driplless.
